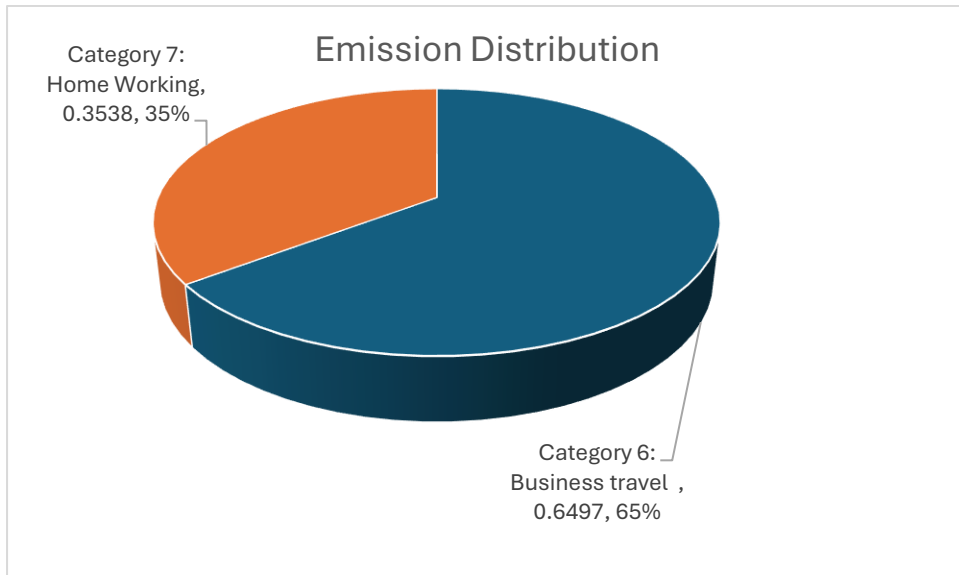

Zero Emissions reasons

Scope 1: Direct Emissions – As we do not own or operate physical facilities or vehicles, our direct emissions are non-existent, reflecting the restrictive nature of our business activities.



Scope 2: Indirect Emissions – Energy consumption is included in our rental agreements, and we have requested details from our landlord regarding the energy provider to ensure it is sourced from renewable, green energy.

Scope 3 Emissions (Categories 1-4) – Due to the nature of our processes, which are primarily digital and service-based, emissions from purchased goods, capital goods, and transportation are minimal or zero.

Scope 3 Category 5: Waste – Waste management services are provided by our landlord, and we have requested details about the service providers to confirm responsible, sustainable waste handling.

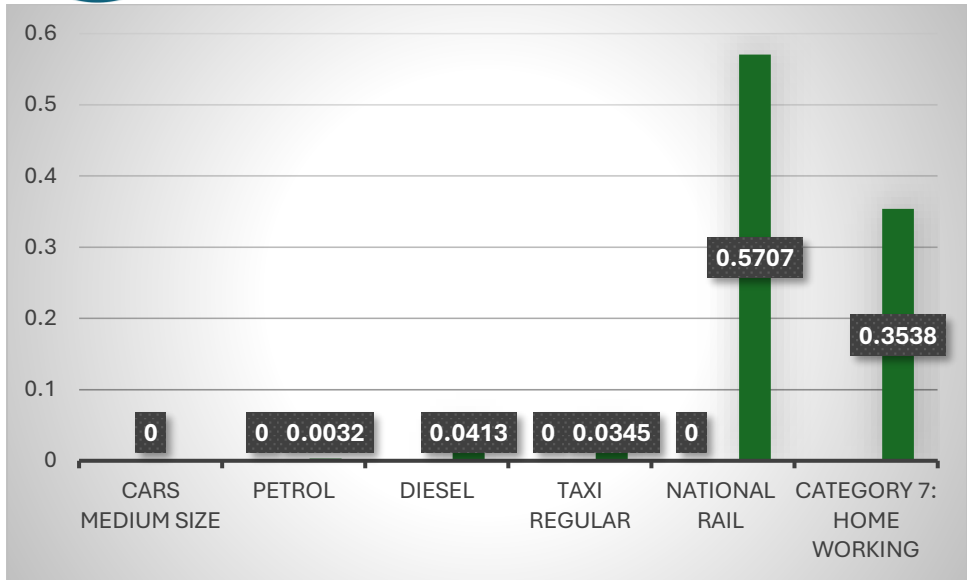

The above chart denotes our emissions in Scope 3.

Current Emissions Reporting 1st Jan – 31st Dec 2023

As this is the first time Xendl Software Limited is preparing a Carbon Reduction Plan (CRP), the baseline year and current reporting year are identical. Our emissions data reflects zero emissions across most categories, with minor contributions from business travel (0.6497 tonnes of CO₂) and employee commuting/home working (0.3538 tonnes of CO₂). This serves as the foundation for future monitoring and improvement as we work towards our carbon reduction and net zero goals.

Emissions reduction targets

As an SME with a minimal carbon footprint, Xendl Software Limited has already implemented policies that meet key sustainability objectives. Our current emissions are low, primarily driven by business travel (0.6497 tonnes of CO₂) and employee commuting/home working (0.3538 tonnes of CO₂). However, we recognise that changes in business operations or growth may lead to variations in emissions in the future.

Our goal is to continue monitoring emissions annually and adapt our strategies as needed to ensure we remain on track to achieve net zero by 2040. Should emissions increase due to operational changes, we will implement further reduction measures, including promoting virtual meetings to reduce travel and encouraging sustainable commuting practices.

Carbon Reduction Initiatives

Xendl Software Limited is committed to aligning our carbon reduction initiatives with ISO 14001 and PAS 2060 standards, ensuring we meet best practices in environmental management and carbon neutrality. Key initiatives include optimising energy efficiency within our operations, reducing business travel by promoting virtual meetings, and encouraging remote working to minimise commuting emissions. We are also working with our landlord to confirm the use of renewable



energy sources and sustainable waste management services. These initiatives are part of our broader strategy to continuously monitor and reduce our carbon footprint, maintaining alignment with internationally recognised sustainability frameworks.
